- Presentations to Crosbie House continue to be completed every 4 weeks. Several committee members were tasked to take turns doing the presentations.

- The pamphlet "What is Peer Support?" was updated and revised with help from Bruce Dienes. It is currently being printed and will be ready for distribution in November.
- Website manager and a committee member have met re: revisions to the website.
